There will be other plants available from nursery stock that have not been listed as yet

Both the *Crinodendron* and the *Ruscus* are unusual plants.

Crinodendron hookerianum is a small evergreen tree with dark green foliage and bright red lantern shaped flowers. It likes a shady, moist site.

The *Ruscus* forms a dense green clump approx. 80cm x 80cm, thrives in shade and once established is drought tolerant, It copes well with tree root competition.

The Ginko is a grafted plant and is a compact variety that grows to 1 ½ M and has buttery yellow foliage in autumn. It is a good plant in a small garden or in a container. Ginkgos are suited to Adelaide and the Hills, and some good specimens can be seen as street trees in Barnard Street, N Adelaide.

The Delphiniums are advanced plants and are just developing flowers.
